His publication includes “Truthmaker Monism”, *Annals of the Japan Association for Philosophy of Science*, vol. 29, 2020 (co-authored with Taishi Yukimoto) and *Thinking Trust: From Leviathan to AI*, Keiso Shobo Publishing, 2018 (in Japanese, editor). He also translated (with colleagues) *On the Plurality of Worlds* (Blackwell, 1986), the 20 century philosopher David Lewis’ masterpiece, into Japanese (Shunjusha, 2016).
